

INTERMEDIATE DRAWING 2A/B

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Duration: 12 weeks. Twelve, 2 1/2-hour class sessions (No class Thanksgiving week)

Maximum students per class: 6 to 12. (Depends on location of classes)

Pre-requisites: Evidence of skills taught in Introduction to Drawing 1A/B

Course cost: \$325

Special note: If you have basic skills in graphite tone control and understand 1-point and 2-point perspective, this course will push those skills. Along with still-life, it focuses on landscape (and cityscape) with an emphasis on researching and organizing real scenes from photos and on-site. This course suggested prior to any painting or pastel courses.

Course Objective

The purpose of this course is to develop draftsmen who can use dry and wet media (pencil, charcoal, ink pen and ink wash, etc.) to make marks on paper that effectively depict a concept, personal object, landscape scene, still life, or structure.

What To Expect As A Result Of Taking This Course

- To understand and effectively use materials common in ink, graphite, and charcoal drawing
- To properly see and skeptically analyze what you think you are seeing
- To effectively represent 3-dimensional objects on a 2-dimensional surface
- To effectively depict the illusion of space and volume through linear and/or atmospheric perspective and with the aid of tonal control through separation of values
- Homework and practice exercises will be assigned each week
- To learn intermediate concepts in composition and organizing elements of a drawing
- To draft convincing drawings (scenes) in aerial perspective
 - Learn to manipulate tone to depict visual separation
 - Use tone, line, texture, and composition to direct eye-flow in drawings
 - Learn skills to control the center of interest
 - Scenic views in aerial perspective (Creating the illusion of depth and space)
- To learn to personally source material, both live and from photographs
