Russian illustrator Valentin Ginukov adds stunning detail along with a bit of whimsy to each of the poems in this fun book. Yucky The Bug


A bug sat beneath a shady leaf She cried and cried with no relief Felling so lonely and unlucky, For she was the bug they called "Yucky."




